Under normal circumstances you would be expecting to receive a report at Easter with your child's effort and attainment grades for every subject that they study. However, given that your child has been working remotely this term, we don't feel that it is appropriate. We recognise that parental engagement in education can, and does, improve pupil outcomes. Consequently, during the first week of the Easter holidays, you will receive a personalised email with details of how your child is performing.

There could well be underlying reasons why a child is performing below the expected level (eg illness/internet issues) and if this is the case, then you will understand.

Categories

- **Commitment to complete work:** Has your child been able to keep up to date with the required work?
- **Attendance at online lessons:** Has your child been able to attend the online lessons (or excuse their unavoidable absence)?
- **Participation:** Has your child been able to participation in an appropriate manner, eg ask questions in lessons/emails?

For each of these categories, a student will receive one of four comments:

- Above expectations (1)
- Meeting expectations (2)
- Below expectations (3)
- Unable to comment (n/a)

This report will only be for the period of school closure and is applicable for years 7-12. Parents of years 11 and 13 will be sent a full written report at a later date.

Should you have any queries relating to the report, please contact your child's year tutor. Once again, thank you for your support and I (hopefully) look forward to seeing your child back in school soon.
